I hear so many stories like this. All in all, life is not easy for the elderly today, and for far too many, life is just downright difficult.


We have helped many less fortunate older folks and with your help, we can help even more people and continue to try to fill in the gaps.”

The Shepherd's Center program was started in 1996 to help folks in the Madison, Inglewood, Old Hickory, and Goodlettsville Areas. It endeavors to provide support and services to older adults who are homebound, but are able to remain in their own surroundings with some assistance from volunteers.

Many seniors face serious health problems, hunger, financial difficulties, insecurity, and the despair that comes from loneliness and isolation. Many have to deal with the loss of their home, spouse, and their sense of purpose in life. The work of The Shepherd's Center of Madison is to fill in the gaps of services.
